

This is a growing competition plant from way back when the parents were *Odontocidium* and *Odontioda*. It is planted in a 150mm pot with mainly 12-18mm *Orchiata* bark. The larger pot probably keeps the mix a little damper, the plant is one where you have to be mindful of when to repot and freshness of mix to get a functioning root system. Flower size is up to 60mm across. CW


