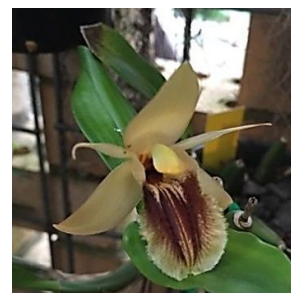

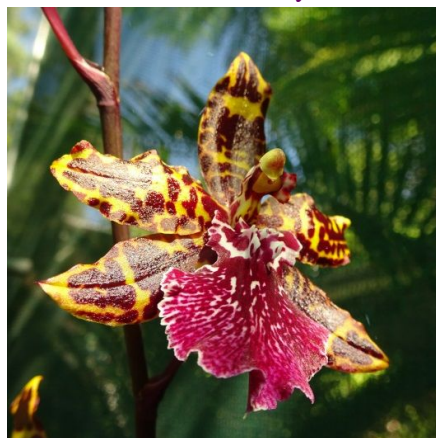

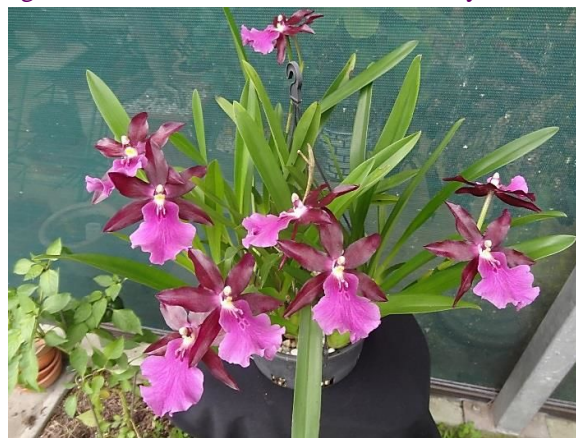

I have previously received a cultural award for this but this year it is even bigger with 30 inflorescences, 310 flowers and 20 buds.

*In Carl Withner’s book, volume on *Laelia*, he had this listed as a species but recent work has this now as a hybrid ***Laelianthe Bowri-Albida***.*

*This is a mericlone of natural hybrid between *Laelia albida* and *Laelia anceps*. The late Brian Gerhard and I imported a couple of these when Brian was with Qantas. He obtained 2 of 80mm mericlones from Santa Barbara Orchid Estate in 1989-90. One of the most free blooming, temperature tolerant *Laelias*. The colour is a vibrant, light, rosy-pink, and the broad cream and pink lip has a deep yellow centre. These pretty, star-shaped flowers are about 6.3cm wide and bloom in clusters on a tall stem. It grows into very fine specimens, with spikes averaging 60cm.*

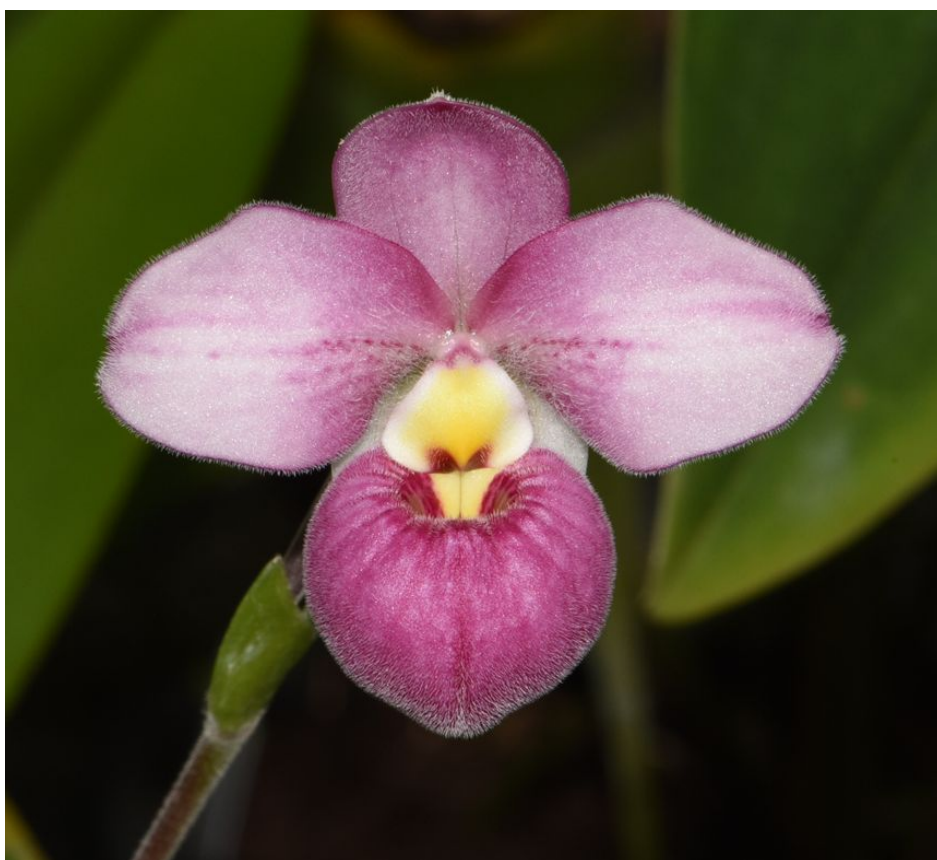
